ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIXTH
SUPPLEMENTAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION –
EXTENSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-26

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Executive Order 20-02 was issued for a declaration of a state of emergency due to the dangers to health and life posed by COVID-19 and that Order has been extended to remain in effect through at least September 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2021, Executive Order 21-26 was issued to amend and restate the quarantine and isolation order and that Order has been extended until August 12, 2021.


